Dress Standards for Special Events: (Junior-Senior, Homecoming, Sports Banquet, etc.)

<u>Young men</u> are expected to look sharp and wear dress shirts with ties. A nice sweater, sport coat, or suit is also appropriate. "Tuxes" are never required but are an option for formal occasions. Appropriate dress socks and dress shoes should be worn by young men.

Young Ladies, the issue of modesty are always applicable to special events. Parents are asked to be involved in the selection process of outfits for such occasions. CCS does recognize that the nature of more formal events allows for considerations that do not pertain to daily school attire. In the area of shoulder coverage, for example, modesty is still important, but narrow straps and "open-shoulder" styles may be worn if they are modest. A shawl, matching jacket/wrap, etc. is always an elegant addition to such designs. Avoid revealing necklines and "low-back" dresses that expose more area than they cover. No tight fitting dresses will be permitted. Dress lengths should be within two inches of the top of the knee, tea length or full-length formal. Slits in dresses cannot expose more than two inches above the knee. If you have concerns about a particular dress, make an appointment before the event with the female staff member designated to help in this area. Students who disregard these guidelines will be appropriately addressed.
